The education system at IESA is divided into the following three main campus, the Early Years Foundation Stage, the Primary School and the High School.

✓ Cambridge Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The Cambridge Early years Stage programme sets standards for the learning, development and care of your child from birth to 5 years old. Your child will mostly be taught through games and play.

- ✓ Communication and language
- ✓ Personal, social and emotional development
- ✓ Physical development
- ✓ Literacy
- ✓ Mathematics
- ✓ Understanding the world

Classes & Ages

- ✓ Pre Nursery (age 2)

- ✓ Reception (age 4)
- ✓ Year 1 (age 5)

✓ Special Classes for Children with Learning Difficulties

- ✓ Identify and address learning challenges (e.g., dyslexia, ADHD, dyscalculia, autism spectrum disorder).
- ✓ Provide a supportive learning environment tailored to each child's needs.
- ✓ Enhance self-confidence and motivation by focusing on individual progress.
- ✓ Use specialized teaching methods such as multi-sensory learning and differentiated instruction.
- ✓ Prepare students for integration into main-stream classrooms when possible.

Special classes for children with learning difficulties are designed to provide individualized support, ensuring that every child has the opportunity to succeed academically and personally. These classes focus on personalized learning strategies, adapted teaching methods, and specialized interventions.



✓ Primary School - Cambridge Primary programme

The Primary school begins at age 6 and continues until age 10.

The Primary school is split up into two sublevels: Lower Primary (Y2 to Y4) and Upper Primary (Y5 & Y6). The subjects taught are as follow:

✗ Lower Primary Subjects

Art and Craft, Comprehension, Creative Writing, French, Global Perspective, Grammar, ICT, Mathematics, Music, Phonics, Physical Education, Reading, Science

✗ Upper Primary Subjects

Art and Craft, Creative Writing, English/Literature, French, Global Perspective, History, ICT, Mathematics, Moral Education, Music, Physical Education, Reading & Comprehension, Science, Social Studies.

✓ Lower Secondary - Cambridge Lower Secondary programme

Years 7, 8 and 9 are the first three years of High School, and they are included in the Lower Secondary.

All students study Art and Craft, Checkpoint Science, Divinity, English Language, French, Geoscience, Global Perspectives, History, Home Economics, ICT, Mathematics, Music, Physical Education, Spanish and STEM.

In Year 9, students sit for the Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint Exam. Year 9 is a very important year, as most of the students make the transition from Lower Secondary to Upper Secondary. It is also a very good foundation for the IGCSE programme.

✓ Upper Secondary - Cambridge IGCSE programme

In the two years of Upper Secondary, which are Year 10 and Year 11, starting at age 14, students prepare for Cambridge IGCSE Exam (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) that is taken after two years.

The Cambridge IGCSE programme prepares international students for A Level.

During the Cambridge IGCSE programme, students study between 7 and 9 subjects from a list of Cambridge IGCSE available subjects. Some of them are compulsory, some are selected by each student according to their abilities and preferences. At the end of the two-year IGCSE programme following the examinations on each studied subject, students receive their Cambridge IGCSE Certificates.

The selected subjects and the IGCSE results are very important for their further studies (A Level) and for their University admission.

✓ Advanced Secondary: Cambridge International AS & A Levels programme

In the two years of Advanced Secondary, which are Year 12 and Year 13, starting at age 16, students prepare for Cambridge International AS Level exam (Advanced Subsidiary) that is taken after one year (in Year 12), and Cambridge International A Level that is taken after two years (in Year 13).

Students specialise in 3 to 5 subjects, that are selected from a list of Cambridge International AS & A Levels available subjects, and usually relevant to the degree subject they wish to follow at university. A Levels are state examinations and are recognised by all UK universities and by institutions worldwide.

At the end of Year 13, following the examinations in each subject, the students receive A Level Certificates.

✗ Cambridge International Exams

Cambridge International Education (CIE) is the world's largest provider of internationally recognised academic qualifications. International English School of Abidjan is a centre for Cambridge International Examination since February, 2024.

Registration is open for Internal & External Private candidates during exam series of May/June & October/November.

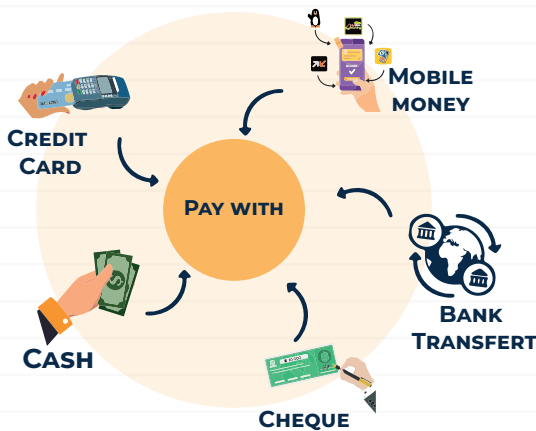
